Membership Team Report 2015

This year the Membership Team had a relatively quiet year. We began with Emma Sousa chairing our team but leaving us mid-way through the church year. While Emma was with us we finished writing our vision and mission statement, conducted a telephone campaign to contact all members and friends, and participated in a parade. Thank you Emma for your time and dedication with our Team! Dave Unger was also part of our team but left us in November. Thank you Dave for your work with us!

Vision: The Membership Team seeks to create and foster lasting, caring relationships with the church, within and outside its walls.

Mission: The Membership Team strives to:

- Greet and embrace visitors, existing members, and friends during worship services, church activities, and outreach efforts.
- Provide and promote a wide variety of service-oriented and social opportunities and to encourage and engage returning visitors and members in participating in those opportunities, uniting them in community and fellowship.
- Maintain connections with returning visitors and members through all mission functions as well as through church-wide communications via weekly newsletters, supplemental email communications, and individual contact.
- Act as a resource for the congregation, providing general information and support and connecting persons to appropriate church resources and departments, including steps to membership.

We launched our Hello Campaign and endeavored to reach out to all members in the directory by phone to just simply say 'Hello'. For the most part it was received very well. It was a great opportunity to share what was up and coming, remind all of Rev. Dr. Janet Newman and Meredith Olson joining us for the September time frame.

Members of our team co-facilitated with the Spiritual Development Team the Introduction to Unitarian Universalism class held the first Sunday of each month. We find this is a great way to introduce visitors to our faith and answer any questions they may have. Typically we have 1-4 visitors join us for the class each month. Thank you to Jerry Ross, June Haskell and Bill Kennedy and Nancy Klarman from Spiritual Development who co-facilitated with Lorraine Arlan, Lori Lerude, Sherri Woolsey and Emma Sousa throughout the year.

Each week we make the Gifts and Talents Survey available to anyone who receives the weekly newsletter. This survey allows us to put information into the database to assist the Membership/Volunteer Coordinator in finding volunteers for activities. So far we have had 39 people fill out the survey. We encourage everyone to please fill it out at their convenience. Thank you Lorraine Arlan and Monica Staples for working on the updates and sending information out to the appropriate committee chairs.

Last Fall approximately 15 members and friends of the Congregation marched in the first Annual Gate City Parade. Lorraine Arlan coordinated behind the scenes to get a new banner made for our church with the assistance of the Public Relations Team. Thank you to Bill Kennedy, Tina Marshman, John Burkitt, Kate Messner, Nancy Klarman and Emma Sousa for assisting with the new banner. Lorraine also worked with an independent company to have t-shirts available to anyone who wished to purchase one that had the Unitarian Universalist chalice on them. Membership tried to offer a fun activity once a month throughout the church year. In October we had a potluck dinner open to everyone. In November we offered bowling at Leda Lanes. We will be trying to offer fun, social events once a month this next church year. Additionally, Nancy Cegalis has offered to resurrect our Circle Suppers this next church year so be looking for information on that.

Stan St. Onge approached Membership about offering a Souper Bowl in January. We loved the idea and had it scheduled for a date in January that unfortunately got cancelled due to weather. Thank you Stan for suggesting it and we will try to make it happen again this next church year. We also sponsored a potluck and games night during Candidating Week for people to come and meet Rev. Allison Palm. Thank you to everyone who came to this and made the evening very fun!
