Leadership Development, 2016-2017

Leadership Development at the Unitarian-Universalist Church of Nashua is an evolving effort to help members of the congregation learn about our many committees/teams/groups and the opportunities for connection, service, and learning that exist. One of the "desired ends" for Leadership Development, as outlined in UUNC's five-year Strategic Plan, is to support active members as they investigate, then take on leadership positions. We are also charged with supporting leaders as they adjust to the responsibilities and challenges of their new positions.

2016-2017 Accomplishments

While we continue to work on clarifying our role at UUCN, we were very pleased to have successfully co-hosted two leadership summits during this past year:

- On October 29, 2016, in partnership with the Stewardship Team.
 During this summit, Harry Purkhiser and Elizabeth Lewis offered an overview of Stewardship at UUCN.
- On March 18, 2017, in partnership with the Board of Trustees. This summit featured an informative presentation about UUCN's form of governance delivered by BoT President David Hudson and BoT member Jodie Holway.

These summits have provided UUCN leaders and potential leaders the opportunity to learn more about Stewardship and Policy Governance at UUCN and to interact with one another. They have also provided a forum for church staff to update leaders about new policies and procedures.

Other accomplishments included:

- A "Team Jump Start" event in August of 2016 for teams to work on their goals for the coming year.
- A "Team Check-in" event in January of 2017 that included a presentation about Google Docs provided by Donna Larue.
- Providing "process monitoring" for one UUCN team.
- Opportunities for UUCN leaders and other interested individuals to attend two New England UUA webinars:
 - o "Cracking the Leadership Crisis" webinar on November 10, 2016
 - o "Leading and Feeling Change" webinar on April 5, 2017

We also plan to create content for leadership information/updates on the newly redesigned UUCN website that will:
