When we met for the annual meeting in June of 2020, we presented to you Our Church Campus Vision Statement. This was created during a joint meeting of the Building Our Vision team and the Board of Trustees. We reviewed the over 400 pieces of feedback items that were collected from the Congregation during five deep listening sessions in early 2020 to assemble what we heard was our vision for the future of our buildings.

In October 2020 we led a worship service to explore the different sections within the Vision Statement. Then we held five follow up conversations to listen to the Congregation's thoughts and reactions to the Vision Statement. We were listening to determine if we were on the right track.

At a special Congregational meeting held on November 15, 2020, the Congregation confirmed that this is the right direction by voting to affirm our Church Campus Vision Statement. Now on to more work!

Since that November meeting, the team has been talking with other churches that have done recent renovations to see who they used for architects and to learn about their process. We have also been going back over the prior feedback from the Congregation to look for more specific changes that were suggested. Finally we have also been reviewing the buildings and grounds priority list developed by the Property Team for future work.. We look forward to having more conversations with the Congregation in the fall to ensure that we are still moving in the right direction.
