

Our programs foster connection and belonging, build community, and provide compassionate support to members when it is needed most.

CONSIDERING OUR EXPENSES

ONE WAY TO CONSIDER OUR EXPENSES:

Look at how the money is used in specific budget categories. *We see that, like many other nonprofits, most of our budget goes to staff costs. We are grateful to have a dedicated staff team at UU Nashua!*

- **Staff Salaries** includes compensation and benefits for staff members.
- **Operations** includes administration, communications, stewardship, UUA annual program fund, and property. Property is the largest portion of operations.
- **Programs** encompasses Worship, Music, Faith Formation, Membership, Social Justice, and Leadership.

BUDGET CATEGORIES

ANOTHER WAY TO CONSIDER OUR EXPENSES:

Look at how the money is used in support of our values. Our programs and services directly reflect our mission and values.

Mission: We are a welcoming community of faith, inspiring lives of wonder, generosity, and courage, serving the world through love in action.

Values:

- **Wonder** includes Worship, Music, and half of the Faith Formation program.
- Authentic Connection includes half of the Faith Formation program, Welcoming, Fellowship, and Pastoral Care.
- Courageous Community includes Leadership, Stewardship, Communications, and our Intern program.
- Love in Action includes our Social Justice and Service work.

OPENING OUR HEARTS

We are asking the congregation to LEAD WITH LOVE by living our values and helping to continue our important programs and services that nurture and strengthen our community.



Our pledge goal is \$425,000, which is approximately 5% higher than last year's budget.



The challenge we face is that the costs of maintaining our current programs rise by approximately 5% annually, necessitating a corresponding increase in income.

CONSIDERING YOUR PLEDGE

What is a pledge?

Each year, our budget is built off the pledges we receive from our members and friends during our annual Stewardship Campaign. Your pledge is a promise to support our ministries and programs throughout the congregational year with a financial gift. When you make your annual pledge, you tell us how much you will be contributing during our church fiscal year, July 1 through June 30. We ask that you make your pledge annually because we make a new budget every year, and we need to know the amount of funds that will be available to support our programs and ministries.

How much should I give?

This is not an unusual question, but there's no one answer for everyone. We hope you can be generous with your financial resources in a way that gives you joy in recognizing your part in furthering our mission. We invite everyone to be on a path of giving 5% of your income per year, or to consider all the charitable giving you hope to do in a year, and pledge half of that amount to the congregation.

Making your commitment on or before March 2, 2025 will enable us to prepare a balanced budget for 2025-2026. Thank you for all that you give to our church community!




